

SERMON TITLE: "Doomsday" to "Boomsday"

Doomsday predictions are made whenever people see an existential threat to the survival of Mankind. Jesus made one in the Olivet prophecy: "And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be

saved..." (MT.24:22). What are the determinants of doom according to your Bible? Jesus also made some predictions of "boom". What are the determinants of how the world will 'boom' according to your Bible?

SEMINAR TITLE: A Biblical & Historical Look at Gog, of Magog

Who is Gog of the land of Magog and where is this land of Magog anyway? Is it a real historic land we can find on ancient maps or is it a mythical place like 'Middle Earth' of the Hobbit series – or the city of Atlantis? Ezekiel 38 says that Gog is the chief prince of Meshek & Tubal. Do we find any historical & Biblical references to these cities? And both Ezekiel 38 and Revelation 20 speak of Gog and Magog leading a coalition of nations against Israel. Are these one and the same event – or 2 different invasions of the Holy Land? We'll answer these and other questions in this seminar – right from the pages of your own Bible!

SEMINAR TITLE: Study Aid for God's Annual Holy Days

Bill will present and share the holy day study aid developed by the Katy (Texas) Christian Fellowship over the last two decades. The study aid (in Excel format) is organized chronologically as the days appear in Leviticus 23 and analyses each observance from 23 different criteria. We have found this a useful tool each year as we prepare for annual observances and the 3 seasons/times. A robust group discussion is welcomed.






